

#### April 09, 2024





आज का युवा कुछ हटकर अलग फील्ड में करियर बनाने में ज्यादा दिलचस्पी रखने लगे हैं। अब विद्यार्थी पारंपरिक कोर्सेज की बजाए जॉब ओरिएंटेड कोर्स को ज्यादा तरजीह देते हैं। वर्तमान की युवाओं की दिलचस्पी के अनुरूप सरकारी राजिंदरा कॉलेज में नए शैक्षिक सत्र 2024-25 में डिग्री, डिप्लोमा 9 तरह के कोर्स शुरू किए जाएंगे। आज की जरूरत के मुताबिक पूरी तरह से स्किल बेस्ड एल्वॉयमेंट ओरिएंटेड प्रोफेशनल कोर्स होंगे।

नई शिक्षा नीति के तहत डायरेक्टर हायर एजुकेशन की ओर से प्रदेश में 17 नए वोकेशनल स्किल फुल कोर्स शुरू किए हैं, जिनमें से 9 नए कोर्स बठिंडा के सरकारी राजिंदरा कॉलेज को मिले हैं। पंजाबी यूनिवसिंटी पटियाला से एफिलिएटेड हैं। सरकारी राजिंदरा कॉलेज की हायर एजुकेशन इंस्टीटयूट सोसायटी के अधीन कॉलेज की सेल्फ फाइनांस स्कीम के तहत करवाए जाने वाले कोर्स की प्राइवेट कॉलेजों से 30 प्रतिशत कम फीस होगी। अलग-अलग कोर्स से संबंधित इंडस्ट्री पार्टनर से विद्यार्थियों को ट्रेनिंग अथवा अप्रेंटिसशिप भी करवाई जाएगी जिससे युवाओं को इंडस्ट्री की जरूरत के मुताबिक विस्टबन टेनिंग हाफिल हो य

#### यूनिवर्सिटी से सिलेबस बनकर तैयार

#### एकेडमिक बैंक ऑफ क्रेडिट का होगा फायदा

नई शिक्षा नीति के अनुरूप करवाए जा रहे प्रोपेशनल वोनेशनल कोर्स में युवाओं को एकेडमिक बैंक आफ क्रेडिट का फायदा मिलेगा। इसमें 1 साल का सर्टिफिकेट कोर्स होगा जबकि दो साल का डिप्लोमा, 3 साल की डिग्री के अलावा 4 साल की डिग्री विद आनर्स का प्रावधान मिलेगा। एकेडमिक बैंक ऑफ क्रेडिट (एबीसी) के अंतर्गत विद्यार्थी को किसी भी वर्ष पढ़ाई छोड़ने और फिर अन्य कॉलेज में दखिला लेने पर सर्टिफिकेट अथवा डिप्लोमा के साथ अब तक अर्जित क्रेडिट का आदान-प्रदान हो सकेगा। भविष्य में उसी या किसी अन्य संस्थान में फिर से दाखिला लेकर अपनी आगे शिक्षा जारी रख सकते हैं। ड्राप आउट करने पर
